## **CONDITIONS**

- 1. Each competitor may enter maximum of three works. The work must be the original work for the competition. THE SIZE OF THE WORK MUST NOT EXCEED 15,000 square centimetres (e.g.  $100 \, \text{cm} \times 150 \, \text{cm}$ ,  $200 \, \text{cm} \times 75 \, \text{cm}$  etc.), and may contain multiple pieces within the above size range.
- 2. Closing date for entries is Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2017. Entries must have been produced by a male artist resident in Australasia during the 12 months preceding the exhibition.
- 3. Entries must be delivered together with a completed entry form, including biographical details and a *non-refundable \$10.00* (inclusive of GST) cash fee (per entry) to The Laird, personally or by agent between the hours of 2.00pm and 8.00pm Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2017.
- 4. The artist must provide details of the media used in the work on the entry form.
- 5. Entries must be clearly marked on the back with the artist's name, address and the title of the work.
- 6. Entries must be suitably framed for handling. A stretched canvas is considered framed.
- 7. Multi panel pieces are accepted and are regarded as one work. Such works should be accompanied by a photo of the assembled work and clear instructions for the installation of the work if selected for hanging. The overall size of the work must comply with condition 1.
- 8. Neither The Laird nor its staff or agents will be responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever, and however caused, to any work. Each competitor is responsible for maintaining his own insurance coverage.
- 9. Competitors hereby grant to the The Laird, JOY 94.9 and Midsumma Festival (non-exclusive) right to reproduce the competitor's work (the Work) in a material form,
  - To publish the Work and to communicate the Work to the public, and to sub-license such rights, (in Australia) for the following purposes and anything incidental to such purposes:
  - To display the Work at The Laird in an exhibition of selected entries for the Men on Men Art Prize in 2017.
  - Advertising and publicising the Men on Men Prize Exhibition in all media, including but not limited to all electronic, broadcasting and print media.
  - Including the Work in the catalogue for the Men on Men Art Prize Exhibition.
  - Publicising the entry winning the Men on Men Art Prize (the Winning Entry) and reproducing the Winning Entry in any publication by The Laird or Midsumma in all media including but not limited to all electronic, broadcasting and print media.
  - Photographic, or permitting the Work to be photographed, at any time between the date the Work is submitted and the date it is collected.
- 10. The winning competitor agrees to make themselves available for the purposes of promotion and publicity at times and dates and in places reasonably requested by The Laird, JOY 94.9 and Midsumma Festival.
- 11. The Judges' decision is final and no correspondence shall be entered into.
- 12. Return of works. If a competitor shall fail or omit to remove a work from the Laird Hotel as provided in these conditions, The Laird, after sending notice by post to the competitor at the last known address for one month's notice of their intention to sell or otherwise dispose of such work, or in the event of no address of the competitor being known to The Laird, JOY 94.9 or Midsumma, may sell such work and after deducting from the proceeds the costs of and incidental to the sale shall hold any balance for the competitor provided, however, that in the event of such work being in the opinion of The Laird, JOY 94.9 and Midsumma un-saleable then they may in lieu of selling, dispose of

it in such a manner as they deem fit and thereafter shall be under no liability whatever to the competitor.

- 13. The Laird will endeavour to hang all compliant entries. Work will be displayed at The Laird from Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> June Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2017. The winner will be announced on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2017 between 10-11pm at The Laird during Mr Australasia Bear Competition (door charge applies). Winners will be notified by phone.
- 14. Work exhibited and not sold must be collected from The Laird between 2pm 8pm Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2017.
- 15. No expenses will be met by The Laird. No returns will be made by rail or post for works not collected.
